From small and growing to large and flourishing, the mix of numbers displayed here gives a beautiful visual of how First Image operates. **Covered in prayer, filled with the Spirit, and financially supported by thousands of partners**, our staff and volunteers have the opportunity to provide tangible assistance to women facing unplanned pregnancies.

Because of support from partners like you, women in the earliest stages of their pregnancy receive hope and education as they determine their next steps. Often overwhelmed and unable to imagine another path forward, a woman will decide to abort within days of discovering her pregnancy. With easy online access, one in four abortions are now prescribed via telehealth – repeatedly without confirming gestational age or exploring other options.

At First Image, we are eager to reach more of the hundreds of women in our community who are experiencing an unplanned pregnancy. Thank you for being part of the mission with us! Your presence and your Christlike love for the women we serve are incredible gifts to us and to our world.

Juana's Story

Juana* contacted our scheduling line late one day and asked what it would cost what it would cost to terminate her pregnancy. **There was no way that she could support a pregnancy at this time in her life**—she already had financial struggles, and practically, it wouldn't make sense.

The scheduler explained that we do not perform or refer for abortions, but that we could potentially provide an ultrasound and information on pregnancy options. Thankfully, Juana agreed to come in the next day. She met with one of our advocates and explained her reality of caring for her kids and her partner; this new-found pregnancy was just another stressor on top of everything else.

When our advocate went over the options brochures and offered each one to Juana, she took all three. She told the advocate about her faith and how conflicted she was about this decision, and the advocate prayed with her. As they moved into the ultrasound portion of her appointment, Juana couldn't stop crying. **This baby meant something to her, but she just couldn't see a way forward with her current life circumstances.** To our surprise, Juana wanted the photos taken during her ultrasound, but, between tears, told the nurse that she was going to move forward with an abortion.

That evening, our advocate called two of her friends and asked them to pray fervently for this conflicted woman—that God would reach down to comfort her and provide her with the peace she needed to choose to carry. The next day, with prayerful optimism, we checked on Juana and offered a follow-up ultrasound. We hoped that maybe a second scan and some extra time to process her situation would give Juana new ideas about how to move forward in her pregnancy. **To our surprise, she told us that she had decided to carry and thanked us profusely for all of our help.**

We have followed up with her since, and she is now enrolled in prenatal care and has expressed a desire to receive baby items from us later in her pregnancy. We continue to pray that God would give her steadfastness, courage, and help as she steps into this new, unplanned reality.
